AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE BOSTON
JUVENILE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 76, as most recently amended by section 8 of
3 chapter 699 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section:—
5 *Section 76.* The salary of the justice of the Boston juvenile
6 court shall be twenty-six thousand four hundred dollars.
