AN ACT PROVIDING RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR LOUISE M. CALLAHAN OF CHESTNUT HILL, A PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHER NOT IN THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, Louise M. Callahan, residing at 56 Sherman
3 road, Chestnut Hill, Massachusetts, a teacher in the public
4 school system, having served as such for a period of more than
5 twenty years, shall be permitted to enter the teachers' retire-
6 ment system upon payment of any amount equal to five per
7 cent of her total earnings as such teacher into the annuity sav-
8 ings fund of the system.
