AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITING CERTAIN UNUSED ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE DAYS TO AN EMPLOYEE OF THE COMMONWEALTH, ACCRUED WHILE AN EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, John J. Lownie, now or formerly deputy sealer
3 of weights and measures for the city of Boston, who has or will
4 become an employee of the commonwealth as an investigator for
5 the alcoholic beverage control commission, shall be credited
6 with one hundred and thirty days of unused accumulated sick
7 leave in his new employment, said sick leave being the same
8 number of sick leave days accumulated while an employee of the
9 city of Boston.
