

Act of 1948. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and said loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit and shall, except as provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE CHARLEMONT FIRE DISTRICT TO CHARLEMONT WATER DISTRICT. *Chap.103*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 231 of the acts of 1931, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out therein the words "Charlemont Fire District" wherever they may appear and inserting in place thereof the words:— Charlemont Water District. Such change of name shall not in any way affect the validity of any obligations assumed or action taken by the Charlemont Fire District prior to the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NORWELL TO BORROW MONEY FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES. *Chap.104*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. For the purposes of constructing a school building, and originally equipping and furnishing such building, the town of Norwell may borrow from time to time, within a period of five years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, two hundred thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the words Norwell School Building Loan, Act of 1948.
