### AN ACT REQUIRING CITIES AND TOWNS TO ESTABLISH DAY CARE CENTERS FOR CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 13B the following section:—
- 3 *Section 13C.* Every city and town shall establish a public
- 4 day care center for children. Said center shall be open to
- 5 children of all parents of the city or town and fees may be
- 6 charged based on the ability of the parents or guardians of
- 7 such children to pay such fees.
