
By Mr. Golden of Framingham, petition of James L. Golden, Jr., that the Commissioner of Correction be authorized to sell to the R. & S. Construction Co. of Boston certain state land in the town of Framingham. Social Welfare.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION TO SELL CERTAIN LAND OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subject to the approval of the governor and
2 council, the commissioner of correction, in the name and on
3 behalf of the commonwealth, may sell and convey to the R. &
4 S. Construction Co. of Boston, for such price as he may
5 determine, a certain parcel of land in the town of Framing-
6 ham held for the purposes of the reformatory for women and
7 no longer needed therefor, said parcel being bounded as
8 follows:—Beginning at a point at the intersection of Mer-
9 chant Road in Framingham and Prospect Street and Perry
10 Street in Sherborn and running along the southerly side of
11 Merchant Street in a westerly direction approximately 1482
12 feet more or less to a brook which intersects Merchant Street
13 as shown on Town of Framingham Assessors Plan, Sheet 181,
14 Block 413. Thence southerly along said brook 2100 feet more
15 or less to the Framingham Sherborn town line. Thence along
16 said Framingham Sherborn town line in an easterly direction
17 approximately 2200 feet more or less to the point of begin-
18 ning; said parcel of land containing 30 acres more or less.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
