AN ACT REGULATING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TAXICAB LICENSES
OR PERMITS ISSUED BY CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 22E the following section:—

3 *Section 22F.* In a city or town in which there is no ordinance
4 or by-law limiting the number of taxicab permits to be issued
5 therein the number of taxicab permits issued therein shall be
6 limited to that number issued the preceding year. In the event
7 that increase is deemed necessary, because of expansion of the
8 public's need and necessity, then application shall be made to
9 the licensing authority of said city or town for such increase.
