AN ACT REQUIRING THE BOARD OF FIRE PREVENTION REGULATIONS TO MAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GRANTING OF PERMITS FOR TESTING AND LAUNCHING ROCKETS FOR STUDY AND RESEARCH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 148 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 9 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 9A.* The board shall make rules and regulations for
- 4 the granting of permits for testing and launching rockets for
- 5 study and research. Such rules and regulations shall require
- 6 the launching to be approved by the chief of the fire depart-
- 7 ment of the city or town within which such launching shall
- 8 take place. Said fire chief shall not approve the launching if
- 9 he determines that the rocket is hazardous to person or
- 10 property or the launching is not under the supervision of
- 11 competent persons.

The Government of Queensland

Public Health Act, 1902

1. The Governor in Council may, subject to the approval of the Executive Council, make regulations for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of this Act, and may from time to time amend or repeal any regulations so made.

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
