### AN ACT REDUCING THE REGISTRATION FEES OF TRUCKS AND TRAILERS USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 4 of chapter 749 of the acts  
3 of 1968, is hereby further amended by inserting after sub-  
4 division (7) the following subdivision:—

5 (8) For the registration of any truck or trailer used  
6 exclusively for recreational purposes, ten dollars. There shall  
7 be no refund of said registration fee unless there is a transfer  
8 of ownership of the vehicle so registered.
