AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE ATLANTIC STATES MARINE FISHERIES COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 489 of the acts of 1941 is hereby amended
- 2 by striking out, in line 6, the word "ten" and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the word:— twenty-five.

For the purpose of the present act, the word "house" shall mean any building or structure, whether or not a dwelling, which is used for the purpose of housing or sheltering any person or persons, and which is situated on any land, whether or not the land is owned by the person or persons so housed or sheltered.

The Commission of Investigation

Section 1. The Commission of Investigation
