RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO SUCH CHANGES IN THE LAW AS MAY BE DESIRABLE IF THE HOME RULE AMENDMENT, SO CALLED, TO THE CONSTITUTION IS ADOPTED.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established by
2 chapter one hundred and thirty-one of the resolves of nine-
3 teen hundred and sixty-five and most recently revived and
4 continued by chapter one of the resolves of nineteen hundred
5 and sixty-eight, shall, in the course of its investigation and
6 study, consider the subject matter of current house document
7 numbered 2600, abolishing the finance commission of the city
8 of Boston.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
