RESOLVE DISCHARGING A MORAL OBLIGATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN FAVOR OF JAMES E. CURRY.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation of the commonwealth, there shall be allowed and
3 paid out of the state treasury, subject to appropriation, to
4 James E. Curry, the sum of five thousand nine hundred and
5 sixty-nine dollars and eighty-two cents for legal expenses
6 incurred in defending himself in a criminal action based on
7 charges arising out of his conduct in his official duties in
8 which he was acquitted after trial in Suffolk superior court.
