AN ACT RELATING TO INFORMATION GIVEN TO CREDIT BUREAUS BY CERTAIN CREDITORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 42 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 43.* Any creditor of any person who has notified a
- 4 credit bureau that the account of such person is delinquent
- 5 shall, upon the payment in full to such creditor by such per-
- 6 son, notify the credit bureau that the debt has been paid in
- 7 full. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be
- 8 punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than
- 9 fifty dollars.
