## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS BY THE COMMONWEALTH TO CERTAIN INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION NOT UNDER PUBLIC CONTROL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The state treasurer shall on or before December thirty-  
2 first of each year make payments to every institution of  
3 higher learning not under public control which shall be  
4 determined as follows:—four hundred dollars for each stu-  
5 dent who was awarded a bachelor's or master's degree in the  
6 previous school year and twenty-four hundred dollars for  
7 each student who was awarded a doctorate degree in the  
8 previous year by such institution; provided, no such institu-  
9 tion shall receive any payment unless it has been approved  
10 by the New England Association of Colleges and Secondary  
11 Schools.
