AN ACT REQUIRING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, THROUGH ITS SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE BUREAU, TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ASSISTANCE TO CITIES, TOWNS AND REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN THE PREPARATION OF EDUCATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR ANY PROPOSED SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948 is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "schools", in line 13,
3 the following words:—to provide professional assistance to
4 any city, town or regional school district in the preparation
5 of educational specifications for any proposed school con-
6 struction.

THE COMPANIES ACT, 1908

Section 104. Power to alter articles of association.

104. (1) Any company may, by special resolution, alter its articles of association, subject to the provisions of this section, and subject to the provisions of any Act in that behalf made.

(2) A special resolution is a resolution passed by a majority of three-fourths of the votes of the members of the company present and voting at a general meeting of which notice has been given in accordance with the provisions of the articles of association.

(3) A special resolution is not valid unless it has been passed by a majority of three-fourths of the votes of the members of the company present and voting at a general meeting of which notice has been given in accordance with the provisions of the articles of association.
