AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR HOLDING OF HORSE RACING MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 128A of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out clause (d) and inserting in
3 place thereof the following clause:—

4 (d) Such horse racing meetings maye be held only between
5 the first day of April and the fifteenth day of December, both
6 dates inclusive in any year; provided, that no harness horse
7 racing meeting other than one at which the racing is not
8 earlier than seven o'clock postmeridian, and no running horse
9 racing meeting shall be held between the tenth day of August
10 and the second Saturday after Labor day, both dates inclusive,
11 except in connection with a state or county fair.

12 SECTION 2. Any monies payable to the commonwealth under
13 the provisions of section one on account of said additional
14 racing days shall constitute a fund, under the supervision of
15 the state treasurer, to be used for the purpose of improving
16 care, maintenance and training of mentally retarded children.
