AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN VETERANS IN THE  
PUBLIC SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 60 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 6 of chapter 498 of the acts  
3 of 1965, is hereby further amended by striking out the second  
4 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following para-  
5 graph:—

6 No veteran whose employment first begins after June  
7 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and forty-six, shall be subject  
8 to the provisions of sections fiftysix to fifty-nine, inclusive;  
9 nor shall any veteran whose employment first began on or  
10 before said June thirtieth be subject to said provisions unless  
11 at the time of his retirement the total period of his creditable  
12 service is at least equal to twice the time he was not in the  
13 employ of the commonwealth or of a county, city, town or  
14 district subsequent to the date when his employment by the  
15 commonwealth or by a county, city, town, district or housing  
16 authority first began.
