AN ACT ABOLISHING THE MEDICAID PROGRAM, SO-CALLED, IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 874 of the acts of 1965 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and insert-
3 ing in place thereof the following:—The governor shall desig-
4 nate the provisions of said law for which each of said depart-
5 ments shall be responsible, provided that the governor shall
6 not designate to said departments the provisions of said Public
7 Law 98-97 of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-five
8 which are contained in Title 19 of said law.

1 SECTION 2. Any designation of the provisions of Title 19 of
2 Public Law 89-97 of nineteen hundred and sixty-five made
3 by the governor to any department prior to the effective date
4 of this act is hereby revoked.
