The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT TO RESCIND AND REVOKE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STATE OF MASSACHUSETTS IN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That from and after the effective date of this
2 act the ratification of the Senate of the United States of July
3 28, 1945, of the United Nations Charter, making the state of
4 Massachusetts a member of the United Nations, be and said
5 ratification hereby is, rescinded, revoked and held for naught;
6 and all acts and parts of acts designed and intended to carry
7 out such membership of the state of Massachusetts in the
8 United Nations, are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
