### AN ACT TO PROVIDE A FLAT EXEMPTION FROM REAL ESTATE TAXES TO DISABLED VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of special or general law to  
2 the contrary, all disabled veterans shall be entitled to an  
3 exemption from real estate taxes in the amount of five hun-  
4 dred dollars. This act shall cease to be effective when the gen-  
5 eral court shall pass legislation granting flat exemptions in  
6 the appropriate sections of section five of chapter ninety-five  
7 of the General Laws to disabled veterans.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE SEVERAL COUNTIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the State in that behalf lawfully convened, on the twenty-first day of February, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight.

1. Notwithstanding any provision of special or general law to the contrary, all disabled veterans shall be entitled to an exemption from real estate taxes in the amount of two-thirds of the full value of the property in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight.
2. The amount of the exemption shall be ascertained in the same manner as the amount of the full value of the property.
3. The exemption shall be granted to the veteran or his widow, or to the person who is entitled to the property.
4. The provisions of section five of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws be amended to read as follows:
