RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MORE EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSIT AUTHORITY DEFICIT AMONG THE SEVENTY-EIGHT CITIES AND TOWNS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, six members of the house of represen-
3 tatives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to the establishment of a more equitable dis-
6 tribution of the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority deficit
7 among the seventy-eight cities and towns.
