AN ACT RELATIVE TO A CHANGE OF ZONING ORDINANCE OR BY-LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 40A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:
3 —No change of any zoning ordinance or by-law shall be
4 adopted for land any part of which is within fifteen hundred
5 feet of land used for private or public educational purposes
6 except by a unanimous vote of all the members of the city
7 council, whatever its form, if it consists of less than nine
8 members or, if it consists of nine or more members, by a
9 three fourths vote of all the members thereof where there is
10 a commission form of government or a single branch, or of
11 each branch where there are two branches.
