By Mr. Langone of Boston, petition of Joseph A. Langone, 3rd, relative to crediting to the General Fund funds received from race meetings in connection with a state or county fair. Ways and Means (Joint).

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CREDITING OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM RACE MEETINGS IN CONNECTION WITH A STATE OR COUNTY FAIR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1 Chapter 128A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 15, as most recently amended by chapter
3 628 of the acts of 1968, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section:—

5 *Section 15.* The receipts paid into the state treasury under
6 this chapter shall be credited to the general fund; provided,
7 however, that of the payments made under section five by
8 licensees conducting racing meetings in connection with a
9 state or county fair, there shall be paid to the agricultural
10 purposes fund the sum of ten thousand dollars to be used
11 in carrying out the provisions of paragraphs (b) and (f) of
12 section two of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight and the
13 balance shall be credited to the general fund.
