AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF COUNTY COMMITTEES IN EACH POLITICAL PARTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 52 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 4 the following section:—

3 *Section 4A.* The chairmen of the several city and county
4 committees in each county shall constitute a county com-
5 mittee and shall hold office in said county committee for
6 four years from May fifteenth following their election and
7 until their successors shall have been chosen.

By the House of Representatives of the State of New York, in session assembled, passed for the purpose of amending the laws relating to the office of the State Comptroller, in and to which amendments are contained in the following bill.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER.

Section 1. The office of the State Comptroller shall be held by one person, who shall be a resident of this State, and who shall be a member of the bar of the State of New York.

Section 2. The term of office of the State Comptroller shall be for a term of four years, and he shall be eligible for re-election.

1. Chapter 22 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 4 the following section:—
2. Section 4.1. The duties of the State Comptroller shall be to examine and certify the accounts of all public officers and corporations, and to report thereon to the Senate and Assembly.
3. Section 4.2. The State Comptroller shall have the right to demand and receive from any public officer or corporation, and to examine and certify the accounts of any public officer or corporation, and to report thereon to the Senate and Assembly.
