By Mr. Malloy of Newton, petition of Paul A. Malloy that provision be made for the licensing of establishments operating and maintaining more than one bar on the same premises for the sale of alcoholic beverages. Government Regulations.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF EACH BAR ON THE SAME PREMISES WHEREIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a
- 2 license for the sale of alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the
- 3 premises shall authorize the operation of one bar only under
- 4 the provisions of said license. An establishment operating and
- 5 maintaining more than one bar on the same premises, for the
- 6 sale of alcoholic beverages shall make a separate application
- 7 for the licensing of each bar on the premises.
