AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS SHALL JOIN A VETERANS' SERVICES DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any
2 city or town having a part-time veterans agent or a part-
3 time veterans service agent shall, at the end of the term of
4 such agent, either join a veterans' service district in the
5 manner provided by section ten of chapter one hundred and
6 fifteen of the General Laws, or appoint a full-time veterans
7 service agent.
