AN ACT AUTHORIZING INVOLVEMENT BY CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS IN THE COMMODITY DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section 5 of chapter 18 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 658 of
3 the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by adding at the end
4 thereof the following sentence:—This involvement may in-
5 clude assistance by non-profit, religious and charitable orga-
6 nizations in the operation of the community distribution pro-
7 gram providing that such organization bears the cost of trans-
8 portation and storage of any goods entrusted to it.
