AN ACT EXEMPTING FROM TAXATION THE REAL PROPERTY OF THE
JAMAICAN ASSOCIATION OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The real property of the Jamaican Association
2 of Boston shall be exempt from taxation under the provi-
3 sions of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws so long as
4 such property is principally and usually devoted to educa-
5 tional or charitable purposes of said association.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January first,
2 nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.
