AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PLACE ADEQUATE SIGNS WARNING MOTORISTS OF THE HAZARDS OF TRAVELING ON ALL MAJOR ROADS, BRIDGES, TUNNELS AND EXPRESSWAYS WHICH ARE IN THE PROCESS OF CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to place adequate signs on all major roads, bridges,
- 3 tunnels and expressways which are under construction or
- 4 repair and open to traffic warning motorists of the hazards
- 5 involved.

The Constitution of the United States

In the Year of the Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven

As the Constitution is the foundation of our government, it is essential that it be preserved in its original form and that its meaning be kept clear and unambiguous. It is the duty of every citizen to know the Constitution and to understand its principles. The following is a summary of the Constitution of the United States.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled, that the Constitution of the United States be printed and distributed to every citizen of the United States.

1. The Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to print and distribute to every citizen of the United States a copy of the Constitution of the United States, in the form and in the number of copies as may be required.
