AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF OVER-TIME TO STATE POLICE DETECTIVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 30A of chapter 149 of the General Laws
