AN ACT INCREASING THE CUMULATIVE SICK LEAVE OF CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE DISTRICT COURTS AND THE BOSTON JUVENILE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, THAT THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES DO HEREBY CONSENT TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE SAID J. EDGAR HOOVER AS ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND POLICE OFFICER OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.

1 Section 9 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the word "agent," where it appears and inserting in place thereof the words "one hundred and forty-eight."
