RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE DEPARTMENT POLICY IN RESPECT TO THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, one member from the department of public wel-
4 fare, one member from the office of attorney general, one
5 member from the department of administration and finance
6 and one member from the department of public health, is
7 hereby established to make an investigation and study of the
8 policy followed by the department of public welfare in respect
9 to the medical assistance program, established pursuant to
10 the provisions of chapter eight hundred and seventy-four of
11 the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-five and executive
12 order number forty-nine.
