By Mr. Belmonte of Framingham, petition of Robert A. Belmonte that the Department of Mental Health be authorized to transfer land at Cushing Hospital in the town of Framingham to the Trinity Mental Health Center. Social Welfare.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO TRANSFER LAND AT CUSHING HOSPITAL TO TRINITY MENTAL HEALTH CENTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of mental health, through its commis-
2 sioner, is hereby authorized to convey to the Trinity Mental
3 Health Center a certain parcel of land located on Dudley
4 road in the town of Framingham, bounded and described as
5 follows:—Northerly by land of the commonwealth approxi-
6 mately 790 feet; Northeasterly by Dudley Road approxi-
7 mately 775 feet; Southeasterly by a way known as Parker
8 Road being land owned by the town of Framingham 1019
9 feet, and Westerly by other land of the commonwealth 1000
10 feet more or less.

By the Secretary of the Board of Health, to wit: That the Board of Health has decided to acquire a certain parcel of land in the town of Framingham, in the County of Norfolk, State of Massachusetts, for the purpose of establishing a health center in said town.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF SAID TOWN TO ACQUIRE LAND BY PURCHASING OR OTHERWISE TO ESTABLISH A HEALTH CENTER.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of social health, through its commis-
- 2 sioner is hereby authorized to convey to the Town of Fram-
- 3 ingham a certain parcel of land located on Dudley
- 4 road in the town of Framingham, bounded and described as
- 5 follows:—To-wit:—
- 6 north 750 feet; Westwardly by Dudley Road approx-
- 7 7 north 775 feet; Southwardly by a way known as Parker
- 8 Road being land owned by the town of Framingham 1010
- 9 feet, and Westwardly by other land of the Commonwealth 1000
- 10 feet more or less.
