AN ACT RELATING TO THE PREPAYMENT OF CERTAIN LOCAL TAX BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 57 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by inserting at the end the
3 following paragraph:—

4 Any city or town may establish an incentive program
5 whereby any bill due hereunder may be reduced by paying
6 the whole or part of the bill before the date on which it is
7 due, provided that such reduction shall be greater than six
8 per cent of the bill multiplied by a fraction of which the
9 numerator shall be the number of days by which the bill is
10 prepaid and the denominator shall be three hundred and
11 sixty-five.
