By Mr. Hogan of Everett, petition of William F. Hogan that provision be made for allocation of funds from the Highway Fund for the reconstruction of certain sidewalks. Transportation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM THE HIGHWAY FUND FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN SIDEWALKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (a) of clause (2) of section 34 of chapter 90 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 603 of
3 the acts of 1962, is hereby amended by striking out the first
4 two sentences and inserting in place thereof the following two
5 sentences:—For expenditure, under the direction of said
6 department, for maintaining, repairing, improving and con-
7 structing town and county highways, or for the reconstruc-
8 tion of sidewalks in public streets, together with any money
9 which any town or county may appropriate for said purpose
10 to be used on the same highways or sidewalks. The said ways
11 and sidewalks shall remain town or county ways and side-
12 walks.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE

ARTICLE I. OF THE CONSTITUTION

SECTION 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

SECTION 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
