AN ACT PROHIBITING THE LIMITATION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH CREDIT SLIPS MAY BE REDEEMED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 14R, under the caption CREDIT SLIPS, the
3 following section: —

4 *Section 14S.* A credit slip issued by a store to a buyer who
5 returns goods, which credit slip enables said buyer to receive
6 other goods of similar value in exchange for the returned goods,
7 shall not contain any limitation as to time when said credit slip
8 may be used.
