1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Insurance is hereby au-
2 thORIZED to sit during the recess of the general court for the
3 purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject
4 matter of chapter six hundred and forty of the Acts of nine-
5 teen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An Act regulating the
6 cancellation of certain insurance policies".

7 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the
8 state house or elsewhere, may travel within or without the
9 Commonwealth, may hold public hearings, may require the
10 attendance and testimony of witnesses under oath and the
11 production of books and records and may expend for clerical
12 and other services and for expenses such sums as may be
13 appropriated therefor.

14 Said committee shall report to the General Court the
15 results of its investigation and study and its recommenda-
16 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary
17 to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same
18 with the clerk of the House of Representatives not later than
19 the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and
20 seventy.
