AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE LAW RELATING TO THE ALLOTMENT OF CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9B of chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in section 1 of chapter 564 of the acts of 1941, as amended by
3 section 46 of chapter 757 of the acts of 1962, is hereby
4 amended by striking out in the third sentence the words "He
5 shall, after requesting a written recommendation from the
6 commissioner of administration," and inserting in place
7 thereof the words—"The Governor or the Commissioner of
8 Administration when designated in writing by the Governor
9 shall" and by inserting after the word "otherwise" the
10 sentence:—If so designated said commissioner shall designate
11 such member or members of his office as may be approved by
12 the governor to exercise the foregoing powers in the absence
13 of said commissioner.

14 The fourth sentence of said section 9B is hereby amended
15 by striking out the words "in advance to the budget director,
16 in such form and at such times as he shall prescribe, a
17 detailed estimate of anticipated expenditures for each such
18 allotment period.": and inserting in place thereof:—to the
19 budget director, in such form and at such times as he shall
20 prescribe, such information as may be required by the gover-
21 nor or the commissioner of administration for making peri-
22 odic and supplementary allotments.
