AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE OF OFFICE UNTIL AGE SIXTY-FIVE FOR JOHN R. KIRCHHOF, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE TOWN OF GRANBY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The tenure of office of John R. Kirchhof, incumbent of
2 the office of chief of police of the town of Granby, shall con-
3 tinue during good behavior until he reaches the age of
4 sixty-five, unless incapacitated by physical or mental disa-
5 bility from performing the duties thereof, but he may be
6 removed therefrom for cause after hearing in the manner
7 prescribed by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one of
8 the General Laws.
