AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF BRISTOL AND PROVIDING THAT HE SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Class IV of paragraph 1 of section 79 of chapter
2 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out
3 the line reading "fourth district court of Bristol".

1 SECTION 2. Class V of said paragraph 1 of said section 79 of
2 said chapter 218, as appearing in section 3 of chapter 818 of
3 the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by inserting after the line
4 reading "second district court of Bristol" the following line:
5 —fourth district court of Bristol.
