AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MATTAPOISETT TO REVOKE ITS ACCEPTANCE OF THE LAW ESTABLISHING A FIRE DEPARTMENT IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
