AN ACT RELATIVE TO PLACING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN INCUMBENTS OF THE POSITION OF MOTOR VEHICLE EXAMINER ON AN ELIGIBLE LIST.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to de-
2 feat its purpose, which is to allow the Registrar of Motor Ve-
3 hicles to retain the services of experienced employees, therefore
4 it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the names of Alan J.
2 Boyd, Santo S. Rizzotto, Peter J. Bartolo, Toivo A. Anderson
3 and Frank E. Adams which appeared on the eligible list for
4 motor vehicle examiner which expired on July twentieth, nine-
5 teen hundred and sixty-eight shall be intersorted with the names
6 of those on the eligible list established for motor vehicle ex-
7 aminer on July twenty-second, nineteen hundred and sixty-
8 eight in accordance with the civil service law and rules for the
9 period of eligibility of the list established on July twenty-
10 second, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
