RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT A MARINA IN BOSTON HARBOR.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-  
3 sentatives, the commissioner of the department of public  
4 works or his designee, the commissioner of the department of  
5 natural resources or his designee, the commissioner of the  
6 metropolitan district commission or his designee, the chair-  
7 man of the Boston Redevelopment Authority or his designee,  
8 and the commodore of the Massachusetts Bay Yacht Clubs  
9 Association or his designee, is hereby established for the pur-  
10 pose of making an investigation and study of the subject  
11 matter of current house document numbered 4468, relative  
12 to authorizing and directing the department of public works  
13 to construct a marina in Boston Harbor.
