AN ACT GRANTING TENURE TO THE INCUMBENTS OF THE OFFICE OF ASSESSORS OF THE CITY OF LOWELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Rudolphe W. Ouellette, Raymond F. Barrows
2 and Arthur J. Keenan, incumbents of the office of Assessors in
3 the City of Lowell, shall hold their respective offices during good
4 behavior until they reach the age of seventy, unless incapacitated
5 by physical or mental disability from performing the duties
6 thereof, but may be removed therefrom for cause, after hearing,
7 in the manner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-
8 one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
