AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN INSURANCE BROKERS AND AGENTS TO REPRESENT AN ASSURED WHEN SO AUTHORIZED AT HEARINGS ON INSURANCE APPEALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 174A of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

3 An insurance agent licensed under the provisions of section
4 one hundred and sixty-three of chapter one hundred and
5 seventy-five and an insurance broker licensed under the
6 provisions of section one hundred and sixty-six of said
7 chapter shall have the right to appear on behalf of the
8 assured pursuant to the provisions of this section when so
9 authorized by him in writing.

1 SECTION 2. Section 11 of chapter 175A of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

3 An insurance agent licensed under the provisions of section
4 one hundred and sixty-three of chapter one hundred and
5 seventy-five and an insurance broker licensed under the
6 provisions of section one hundred and sixty-six of said
7 chapter shall have the right to appear on behalf of the
8 assured pursuant to the provisions of this section when so
9 authorized by him in writing.
