AN ACT PROVIDING FOR OVERTIME COMPENSATION FOR CAPITOL POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 31 of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sen-
3 tence:— Any member of the capitol police who is required to
4 be on duty in excess of his regular hours of duty as from time to
5 time established shall be compensated for such period of over-
6 time duty at the hourly rate of his regular compensation for his
7 average weekly hours of regular duty.
