AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY MAY BORROW TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A NEW COURT HOUSE FOR THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN WORCESTER IN THE TOWN OF UXBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 342 of the acts of 1968 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in
3 place thereof the following sentence:—For the purposes
4 authorized by section two, the treasurer of said county,
5 with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow
6 upon the credit of the county such sums as may be neces-
7 sary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, nine hundred thousand
8 dollars and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor,
9 which shall bear on their face the words Second District
10 Court of Southern Worcester Court House Loan, Act of 1968.
