

HOUSE No. 5466

By Mr. Flynn of Bridgewater, petition of David L. Flynn (by vote of the town) that the town of Middleborough be authorized to extend the time within which said town may levy assessments for the cost of certain betterments. Local Affairs.

AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME DURING WHICH THE TOWN OF MIDDLEBOROUGH MAY LEVY ASSESSMENTS FOR THE COST OF CERTAIN BETTERMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the failure of the town of
2 Middleborough to comply with the provisions of sections one
3 and two of chapter eighty and section forty-two I of chapter
4 forty of the General Laws, said town may levy and collect
5 assessments for betterments comprising water and sewer exten-
6 sion programs for the years nineteen hundred and sixty-six,
7 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, nineteen hundred and sixty-
8 eight, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine and nineteen hundred and
9 sixty-five.

1 SECTION 2. The recording by the town of Middleborough of
2 the orders, plans, estimates and assessments required under
3 the provisions of sections one and two of chapter eighty and
4 of section forty-two I of chapter forty of the General Laws is
5 hereby validated and confirmed, notwithstanding the failure of
6 said town to record the same within the time prescribed by
7 said sections.
