AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF QUINCY TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL PENSION OF EDWARD P. FRANCIS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The annual pension payable to Edward P.
2 Francis, an employee of the city of Quincy for twenty-nine
3 years, one month and thirteen days, and who was retired
4 through the operation of the compulsory retirement law,
5 under the provisions of chapter four hundred and ninety of
6 the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-one, shall be increased
7 to an amount equal to seventy-two per cent of the annual
8 rate of compensation payable to him on the date of his
9 retirement.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to
2 the contrary, the annual amount of pension payable to this
3 employee of the city of Quincy who is retired under the
4 provisions of said chapter four hundred and ninety shall be
5 established at seventy-two per cent of the annual rate of
6 compensation payable to the employee.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Quincy.
