HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, August 7, 1969.

1    *Ordered*, That the Legislative Research Council be directed  
2 to study the compensation and related financial benefits avail-  
3 able to members of the judiciary in the other states. In the  
4 course of its study said Council shall consider the method of  
5 appointment, tenure, workload, circuit assignments, inherent  
6 jurisdiction and such other matters having relevancy to the  
7 operations of the various courts. Said Council shall report the  
8 results of its study by filing a report of the same with the  
9 Clerk of the House not later than the last Wednesday of  
10 January in the year nineteen hundred and seventy.
